IP College Releases Vol. 2 Issue 1 of Journal of Innovation for Inclusive Development (JIID)

The Centre for Earth Studies (CES) at Indraprastha College for Women, University of Delhi released the second issue (Vol.2, Issue 1) of its Journal, the Journal of Innovation for Inclusive Development (ISSN 2456-4478) on 19 April 2017. The second issue of the Journal was released by Prof. Radhey Shyam Sharma of the Department of Environmental Studies, University of Delhi along with Dr. Babli Moitra Saraf (Principal, IP College & Patron of the Journal) in presence of Journal Editorial Board members.

A Tree Census Report of IP College was also released on the occasion. The Tree Census of IP College was carried out by the Department of Environmental Studies of the College in 2015-16. According to the Tree Census, a total of 803 trees are recorded in the College campus. In terms of diversity, 91 different species of trees are found in the campus. The release of JIID and Tree Census Report was followed by an interactive talk by Prof. Radhey S. Sharma where he highlighted various aspects of Environmental Studies.
